What are cookies

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies

The pages of the Brick Cafe website (www.brickcafesofia.com) use a number of cookies:

We use two Cookie types – based on user session and fixed. User session cookies are temporary files, which stay on the user's device until the end of his/her browsing session or the browser is closed. Fixed files remain on the user's device for the period, defined from the cookie or until they are deleted by the user.

Third party cookies:

- for analytics – we use cookies of analytics tools (like Google Analytics) that collect statistical information for our users and their behavior in our website. The information is anonymous and doesn't contain any personal data.

- for targeting and advertisement – we use cookies of third party advertising solutions (Google AdWords and Facebook) which may show you our advertisements after you have visited our website. These ads will be tailored to your interests, as they take into consideration the pages you have already visited on our website.

The cookie-related information is not used to identify you personally. These cookies are not used for any purpose other than those described here.

How to control cookies

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see AllAboutCookies.org.

You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.
